1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

2 RULES AND ELIGIBILITY

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020* and any amendment thereto, the Prescriptions of Irish Sailing (IS), ECHO handicapping system rules, the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions (SIs). Competitors will be considered honorary members of Arklow Sailing Club for the duration of the event.

3 CLASSES/DIVISIONS

The regatta is open to all classes of racing cruisers. Class divisions will be determined by entry numbers and their ratings.

4 RACING AREA

Racing Area shall be the waters of Arklow Bay, East Coast of Ireland. This area is covered by Admiralty Charts Number 633 or 1787

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

First Gun at 1055hrs on Sunday 27th May 2018.

6 PRIZES

Prize giving will take place in Arklow Sailing Club following racing and protests.

7 REGISTRATION AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All entrants shall register with the Race Office in Arklow Sailing Club.

The Race Office will be open on Saturday 26th between 1600-2000hrs and between 0800-0900hrs on Sunday 27th May 2018.

Cost of entry €50.

A copy of the Sailing Instructions will be provided.

8 Berthing

Berthing is available on the river pontoons and in Arklow Marina.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner(s) or the owner's representative whose obligation it is to ensure that the boat is fully sound, seaworthy, manned by an experienced crew and equipped with all the necessary safety equipment. No action of the organising authority in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of the owner(s) or owner's representative. Boat owners and competing crew shall ensure that they are adequately insured against loss, damage or injury to persons, boat or equipment at all times and however occurring and shall maintain 3rd party insurance cover of not less than three million euro(€3,000,000) and shall produce a valid certificate of insurance upon request. No responsibility shall be accepted by the organising authority, its members, servants or agents, nor those officials or members connected with the event for any loss, damage, injury or other claim of whatever nature howsoever arising or caused in connection with participation in, or intended participation in this event.
